I write to request a timely update on the Inspector General's current investigation into the allegations resulting from Major Clarence Anderson's 2015 court-martial.

As you may know, on April 22, 2015, Major Clarence Anderson III was convicted of sexual assault and other related charges in a general court-martial trial. Since his conviction, Major Anderson has maintained his innocence and produced accounts of alleged bribery, evidence suppression, and witness tampering throughout his court-martial, military appeal, and Federal appeal.

I have been informed by staff in the offices of former-Senator Doug Jones, former Congressman Martha Roby, and Congressman Louie Gohmert that the Air Force Inspector General is conducting a formal investigation into these allegations. Respectfully, I ask that my office be provided an update on this investigation as soon as possible.

I am confident that we share a commitment to truth and justice, and knowing this, I look forward to receiving your update and ultimately, the results of your thorough investigation.
